Other local attractions include:


- Chester Zoo the UK's number one zoo, 110 acres with over 7,000 animals and 400 different species.

- Pryors Hayes Golf Club an 18 hole course covering an area of 5,915 yards in total.
- Beeston Castle a 13th century castle with stunning views over the Cheshire countryside.
- Staircase Locks and Bunbury Water Mill.
- Sandstone Trail an airy walk following the sandstone ridge that rises dramatically from the Cheshire plain.
- Delamere Forest ideal for walking or you can hire a bike and ride the forest trails.
- Weekly farmers' markets at Beeston or Nantwich.
- Shopping Nantwich and Tarporley contain plenty of independent retailers and specialist shops.
- Excellent pubs, one within walking distance and restaurants within easy reach.

Should you wish to have a night out on the town in Chester or Nantwich, or in one of the many picturesque villages, a local taxi can be arranged - just ask at the office.

Our Location

We are situated in the North West of England, in the heart of the Cheshire countryside, just 7 miles from the market town of Nantwich and 17 miles from the city of Chester.

Liverpool and Manchester are approximately 40 miles away. The North Wales border is also close by.



The easiest route to find us, especially for caravans, is either via M6, exit junction 16 and take the A500 (A51) towards Chester. Continue until you reach Calveley, cross the bridge by the Davenport Arms and after 400m take the first right turn. Or via M56, exit junction 10 and take the A49 towards Tarporley. Then take A51 towards Nantwich until you reach Alpraham, take the left hand turn on the bend. Drive down Long Lane, a quiet country road for 2 miles and New Farm is clearly sign-posted on the right hand side.
